


- The transformative budget for the FY 2018/19 is **Ksh.** 7,632,055,820
- Of which 87.9 percent will be financed through equitable share and conditional grants from the national government.
- 13.1 percent of the budget will be financed from own revenue collections.



Sources of revenue for the Ksh.7.632 billion




Summary of County's Development and Recurrent Budget

- The county development budget is Ksh 2.476 million.
- The total recurrent budget is Ksh 5.156 billion of which Ksh 3.599 billion is salaries, wages, insurance and allowances while Ksh 1.557 billion budgeted for operations and maintenance costs

Key activities earmarked for the financial year 2018-2019

- Ksh 300M for purchase of medical drugs and other nonpharms.
- Ksh 36M for Bima Afya (NHIF for the elderly).
- Ksh 100M for Elimu Fund (Bursary).
- KShs 30M for development of a county valuation roll (phase II) and KShs 40M for the spatial plan

- Ksh 236M for Urban Planning and Development of Nyeri Town through Kenya Urban Support Program
- Ksh 210M for improvement and equipping of the Health Facilities
- Ksh 9M for refurbishment of fire stations (Mweiga, Mukurweini, Othaya) and Karatina Children's home.
- Ksh 12M for Digitization of HR Records, purchase of biometric Machines and Human Resource policy development
- Ksh 80M for agricultural related development activities
- Ksh 11m for upgrading of Wambugu ATC
- Ksh 15M for upgrading of Naromoru AMS
- Ksh 20M for Enterprise Development Fund
- Ksh 46M for markets rehabilitation
- Ksh 35 M for improvement and equipping of ECDEs
- Ksh 29M for improvement and equipping of Youth Polytechnics
- Ksh 29M for improvement of county stadiums
- Ksh 270M for water services
