THE KISUMU COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2014**A Bill for**

AN ACT of the Kisumu County Assembly to provide for the various taxes fees and charges for services and for the other revenue raising measures by the County Government; and for the matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Kisumu County as follows—

PART I—PRELIMINARY

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Act, 2014 and shall come into operation on such a date as the County Executive Committee Member for Finance, with the concurrence of the Governor, may appoint and the different date may be appointed for different provisions.

2. (1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

“authorized channel” means the channel through which persons to whom this Act is applicable shall effect payment to the County, including but not limited to a person appointed as a County Revenue Collector by the County to collect revenue or any other mode of payment as may be prescribed by the County Government from time to time;

“business” means—

- (a) trade, commerce or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation;
- (b) any other activity in the nature of trade, commerce or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation;
- (c) any activity carried on by a person continuously or regularly, whether or not for gain or profit and which involves, in part or in whole, the supply of goods or services for consideration;

“cess” means tax or fees chargeable on goods under section 7;

“County Government” means the County Government of Kisumu;

“county public officer” means a county public officer within the meaning of section 2 of the County Governments Act, 2014;

“County Receiver of Revenue” means the persons appointed pursuant to section 157 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012;

“County Revenue Collector” means the county public officer appointed pursuant to section 158 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 for the purpose of collecting revenue for the County Government and remitting it to the County Receiver of Revenue

“person” shall mean a natural or juristic person.

PART II—TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES PAYABLE AND RATES APPLICABLE

3. (1) The Taxes, Fees and Charges set out in the “New Charges” column of the schedule shall apply for the respective items listed in the “Item Description” column at the rate set out therein.

(2) For greater certainty, the taxes, fees and charges applicable are payable to the County Government of Kisumu at the commencement of this Bill, but which are not included in the schedule to this Bill, shall continue to apply under the existing by-laws of the defunct City Council Kisumu, County Council of Nyando, Town Council of Ahero and Town Council of Muhoroni until such by-laws are specifically repealed or replaced by County Government of Kisumu Legislation.

4. (1) All directions, resolutions, orders and authorizations on or relating to financial management, including the collection and administration of taxes, fees and charges given or issued by the defunct City Council and subsisting or valid immediately before the cessation of the application in the Local Government Act, CAP 265 of Laws of Kenya (now repealed) shall be deemed to have been given, issued or made by or under the authority of the County Assembly until expiry, amendments or repeal of this directions, resolution, orders, authorization on financial management shall continue with the necessary

modification, apply both to the payment and administration of the taxes, fees, charges and other levies under this Bill.

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to the specific respective amounts payable in respect of the taxes, fees, charges or other levies and, in that regard, the amount provided shall be applicable as provided for in the "New Charges" columns in the Schedule.

(3) All directions, resolutions, orders, authorizations and provisions that are contained in the County Revenue Act, County Rating Act, County Revenue Administration Act, County Tax Waiver Administration Act, Kisumu City Single Business Permit Regulations, Public Financial Management Act, 2012 and other related laws and subsidiary legislations that are concerned with revenue administration in the county shall be deemed to be part of this Bill.

5. (1) A person shall not carry out any business or service within the County without a valid licence or permit issued by the relevant County office.

(2) A person who intends to carry out any of the businesses listed in the or under the schedule or the single business permit regulation shall apply for a licence or permit from any of the County offices or such other designated agents as shall be prescribed by the County Government from time to time.

(3) A person who applies for licence under subsection (2) shall be issued with a licence on the payment of the applicable fee, depending on the location and size of the business as specified in the schedule or the single business permit regulation.

(4) Licences and permits issued under subsection (3) must be visibly displayed at the business premise at all times

(5) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

6. (1) A person occupying any plot, stall or house leased or rented out by the County Government shall pay rent or rates, whichever is applicable, at the rate specified in the Schedule

(2) A penalty of three percent per month shall be charged for any outstanding amount of rent or rates for a plot that remains unpaid for after the 31st day of March, 2014.

(3) A person who contravenes the provisions of subsections (1) may be evicted and shall be evicted if he or she fails to pay house rent for three consecutive months.

(4) The County Government shall repossess the plot if a person fails to pay the rent for more than one year.

7. (1) A cess or market fee shall be charged on the goods specified in the Schedule.

(2) A person who fails or hinders other person to pay the cess or market fee set under schedule commits an offence.

8. (1) All person operating single business permits shall be required to pay the relevant licenses, fees and charges sa prescribed in the single business permit.

(2) Any person operating a business who fails to pay the said fees, charges or licenses set under schedule and the single business permit regulations commits an offence.

9. (1) The County Executive Committee Member may by order published in the gazette amend any additional fees, tax, license, cess and fees schedules to supplement the current schedule.

(2) Any order made under subsection (1) shall be laid before the County Assembly without unreasonable delay, and unless a resolution approving the order is passed by the County Assembly within twenty one days when the Assembly next sits after the order is so laid, the order shall lapse, but without prejudice to anything previously done there under.

PART III—PAYMENT

10. (1) All payments to the County Government made under this Bill shall be paid through an authorized channel.

(2) A County Revenue Collector authorized by the County Government to collect revenue shall have an identification card issued by the County Government which shall be worn visibly by such County Revenue Collector.

(3) An official receipt shall be issued for all payments made to the County Government.

(4) Every person who makes a payment through an authorized channel shall demand an official receipt for each such payment and every payment made through an authorized channel shall be evidenced by an official receipt.

(5) A person shall not receive or collect any money on behalf of the County Government unless he or she has been appointed to do so or has authority as the receiver and collector of County Government Revenue.

(6) A person who contravenes the provisions of this section commits an offence

11. (1) The County Executive Committee Member may by written notice addressed to any person:

- (a) appoint any person to be an agent of the County Government for the purposes of the collection or recovery of charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees, as may be necessary for carrying out the purposes of this Bill; and
- (b) specify the amount of charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees to be collected or recovered by the agent.

(2) An agent appointed under this section shall enforce and ensure due compliance with the provisions of this Bill and shall remit all revenue collected to the County Government through the County Receiver of Revenue or as may be otherwise instructed in the appointment notice.

(3) Where an agent claims to be, or to have become unable to comply with subsection (2), such shall, within seven working days, notify the County Executive Committee Member in writing, setting out fully the reasons for his inability to comply, and the County Executive Committee Member shall accept the notification and cancel or amend the appointment notice accordingly.

(4) Unless and until a notification is given by an agent under subsection (3), sufficient moneys for the payment of charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees specified in the agent's appointment notice shall be presumed to be held by him and this money shall be due

and payable to the County Government.

(5) For the purposes of this section, the County Executive Committee Member may, by notice in writing, at any time, require any person to furnish him or her, within reasonable time not being less than seven days from the date of service of the notice, with information showing any moneys which may be held by the agent for, or due by him to the County Government

(6) Where an agent fails to pay an amount of money collected under this section within the time specified in the notice, the provisions of this Bill relating to the collection and recovery of tax shall apply to the collection and recovery of that amount as if it were tax due and payable by the agent, the due date for the payment of which was the date upon which that amount should have been paid to the County Government under this subsection.

(7) An agent who makes a payment to the County Government under this section shall for all purposes be deemed to have acted under the authority of the County Government and shall be indemnified in respect of that payment against all proceedings, civil or criminal, and all processes, judicial or extra-judicial, notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in any written law, contract or agreement.

(8) Any person who wilfully makes any false or misleading statement, or wilfully conceals any material fact shall be guilty of an offence.

PARTIV—OFFENCES AND PENALTIES

12. Any person who commits an offence under this Bill for which no penalty is provided shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

13. A member of staff of the County government or any other person having a duty to perform under this Bill who—

- (a) makes , in any record, or document required to be kept or made by that person, an entry which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe not to be true or to be false;

- (b) will fully refuses to do anything which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to know is required to be done;
- (c) interferes with any other person or process under this Bill, so as to defeat the provisions, requirements or purposes of this Bill;
- (d) where required under this Bill to do anything to give effect to the provisions of this Bill, fails to do such thing;
- (e) without reasonable cause omits to do something in breach of his or her duty under this Bill;
- (f) will fully contravenes the provisions of this Bill to give undue advantage or favour to another person;
- (g) fails to prevent or report to the County Government or any other relevant authority, the commission of an offence committed under this Bill;

commits an offence and is liable on conviction, to a fine not exceeding two hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year, or both.

PART V—MISCELLANEOUS

14. (1) Any charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees payable to the County Government at the commencement of this Bill by any business operating within the county which are not included in any of the Schedules to this Bill, shall continue to be chargeable by, and payable to the County Government unless they are repealed by an Act of the County Government or until an Act of the County Government on such charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees is enacted.

(2) All business within the jurisdiction of the county shall be required to pay licenses, charges, fees, cess, rent or other prescribed fees unless specifically exempted by any relevant legislation or authority.

(3) All levies, charges, tax, cess, fees and licenses that were payable under the repealed Local Government Act shall continue to be paid and administered under this Bill: provided that this sub-section shall also apply to such fees and charges levied by various ministries and departments

of the national government in respect of functions devolved to the county governments under part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya which fees and charges shall be levied by the County Government on transfer of the devolved functions.

(4) All references to Councils shall include all Local Authorities as were defined under the now repealed Local Government Act, Cap. 265 of the laws of Kenya.

(5) All references to Councils shall include all Local Authorities as were defined under the now repealed Local Government Act, Cap, 265 of the laws of Kenya.

15. Unless otherwise provided in this Bill, the rates for fees, charges, licences, cess or rent, applicable before the commencement of this Bill in respect of any business, Activity, goods or services listed in the schedules, shall cease to apply.

16. The County Executive Committee Member may make regulations for the better carrying out of the purposes and provisions of this Bill.

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill is prepared pursuant to the standing Order of the Assembly which requires the County Finance Bill to be presented to the Assembly as a legislative proposal.

The object of the bill is to impose or vary the various taxes, licenses, fees and other service charges that are payable to the Kisumu County Government. These are set out in the Schedule. The said Schedule sets out the rates in Kenya shillings (KSh.) The proposed streams of revenue collection are intended to enhance the revenue payable to the County Government so as to ensure better service delivery and also to enable the County Government to perform the increased functions bestowed on it by the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution.

Statement on Delegated Powers to Legislate

The Executive Committee Member responsible for Finance is empowered to bring into operation the various provisions of the Act or certain sections of the Schedule. This is to enable the putting in place of the necessary physical, administrative and personnel infrastructure that would aid in the operationalisation the collection of the proposed taxes, fees and charges.

Part I provides for preliminary provisions.

Part II provides for power to charge licence fees, rent and cess. **The Part** further provide powers to the County Executive Committee Member responsible for finance to amend any of the Schedule through an order published in a gazette.

Part III provides for payment to the county to be made through an authorised channel. It requires receipt to be issued for all payments made to the County and provides for an offence for a person that contravenes the provisions of this part. It also provides for appointment of agencies for the assistance in revenue collection and recovery and duties of the agent.

Part IV provides for a general penalty for failure to comply with any provisions of the Act. It also provides for offences by the staff of the County including the penalty for the offences. This provides recourse if a person is aggrieved by non performance of the County officers.

Part V provides for savings of any of the fees, charges, permit, rent or cess that is currently being charged by the County until such fees, charges, permit, rent or cess is repealed or a law is enacted to provide for it. It also provide for savings of directions, resolutions or authorization that were issued by Municipal Councils, Town Councils and County Councils that were in the County, relating to financial

management to ensure the financial base of the County is not affected by the enactment of this law. It further provides for the County Executive Committee Member to make regulations for the better carrying out of the purposes and provisions of this Act.

The enactment of this Bill shall occasion additional expenditure of public funds that will be provided in the budget estimate.
