THE ELGEYO MARAKWET COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2014

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Elgeyo Marakwet County to provide for the revenue raising measures of the County Government of Elgeyo Marakwet County for the year 2014 for connected purposes

MADE by the Elgeyo Marakwet County Assembly as follows

	PART I—PRELIMINARY
Short title and commencement.	 (1) Act may be cited as the Elgeyo Marakwet County Finance Bill, 2014 and shall, subject to section 2(2), come into operation on such a date as the County Executive Committee Member for Finance may appoint and different dates may be appointed for different provisions (2) The respective taxes, fees and charges, together with the rates applicable shall take effect in not later than three months after the commencement of this Act.
	PART II— FEES AND TAXES PAYABLE AND RATES APPLICABLE
Interpretation	 2. (1) The taxes, fees and charges set out in the Second column of the First Schedule shall apply for the respective services and at the rates set out therein. (2)For greater certainty, the taxes, fees and charges applicable at the commencement of this Act shall continue to apply under the existing by-laws of the defunct Councils of Elgeyo Marakwet until such by-laws are repealed and replaced by county legislation. (3) For purposes of Iten Township, the rates, fees and charges payable under section 2 shall be applicable to all business being operated within a radius of (3) three kilometers from the central business district.
Property Rates	3. The revenue raising measures of the county government relating to property rates are set out in Schedule 1
Trade Licenses	4. The revenue raising measures of the county government relating to trade license Act
Other fees and charges for services	 5. (1)The revenue raising measures of the county government relating to fees and charges for services are set out in Schedule 3 (2) This section does not apply to fees payable under the Elgeyo Marakwet County Trade License Act
No prejudice to charges for services	6. The revenue raising measures of the county government provided for by the Act do not in any way prejudice national economic policies, economic activities across county boundaries or the national mobility of goods, services, capital or labour.

transitional provision	7.	If any national Act mentioned in Schedule 3 has not been amended to provide for the imposition of the fees or charges for services by the county government, then Item 7 of the Sixth Schedule of the Constitution applies in relation to that Act.
Fees and charges authorized by contracts etc.	8.	To avoid doubt , nothing in this Act is to be taken to prevent a county government from entering into a contract or agreement or other arrangement to provide a service upon payment of a fee or charge

This is to enable the putting in place of necessary physical, administration and personnel, infrastructure that would and in the operationalisation of the collection of the proposed taxes, fees and charges.

The operationalisation of certain provision of the proposed law shall entail on expenditure of public funds will be provided for in the estimates.
